ADMISSION

- \$10 per person, inside vehicle. CARSEAT passengers are free. Payment will be taken at the entrance of property.
- ENTRANCE FEE PAYMENTS: CASH or CARD. ELECTRONIC PAYMENTS WILL REQUIRE AN ADDITIONAL \$5 FEE.
- All individuals not competing in the cook off must be off the premises by 11 PM FRIDAY & Midnight ON SATURDAY

- COOK TEAMS ARE NOT REQUIRED TO OFFER SAMPLES OR PLATES. THE COOK AREA IS DESIGNATED FOR COMPETITION TEAMS AND ARE CONSIDERED PRIVATE PARTIES.

FOOD & BEVERAGE

Rules and Regulations | SET UP, SALES & TEAR DOWN

- Each Vendor will have a 10X10 space premises, indoors.
- Vendor Fee is \$25. Badge pick up is the Wednesday before, at 4:00 pm at the PVFD.
- Vendors will receive 2 Vendor Badges only. All other guests must pay general admission upon arrival.
- Vendors are required to set up Saturday morning, BEFORE 9:00 am (doors open at 9 am)
- Vendors may NOT sell any food or beverages
- Clean up and off premises by 6:00 pm Saturday night

STUDENT COMPETITIONS

CTE Rules and Regulations | Open to ANY '23 - '24 ENROLLED Royal ISD Student – Student ID number required at online registration. Competitors ONLY get an event badge to enter the property.

- Floral (6TH TO 12TH GRADE) team of 1 or 2, design floral arrangements, wreath, horticulture outdoor planter. Must NOT BE LARGER than the dimensions of 6 ft length, 6 ft height, 6 ft width.
- Welding (6TH TO 12TH GRADE) team of 1 or 2, create any functional firepit, BBQ barrel, or any other like items. Must NOT BE LARGER than the dimensions of 6 ft length, 6 ft height, 6 ft width.
- Woodshop (6TH TO 12TH GRADE) team of 1 or 2, create any functional pair or rocking chairs, outdoor bench, other seating/furniture items. Must NOT BE LARGER than the dimensions of 6 ft length, 6 ft height, 6 ft width.
 - TURN IN SATURDAY 9:00 AM 9:10 AM INSIDE FIRESTATION BARN
 - CTE Judging 2:00 3:00 pm will be based on 50 points, decimals are allowed to determine placing. Judging will be based on these categories: Creativity, functionality and/or complexity, quality, appeal, & sale probability.
 - Each CTE will be entered into a silent auction. The winners of the silent auction will be announced Saturday at 5:30 pm and the winner MUST PAY the **ROYAL AG CLUB** at the time of pick up, no later than Sunday April 14th. A donation receipt will be sent to the live winner via email within 7 business days.
 - If the exhibitor sells their item, they will receive a check from the Royal Ag Club.



- Baking | (ages 8 12 years ONLY: AGE AT TIME OF COMPETITION.) team of 1 or 2, turn in a baking item enough for 9 ONE BITE CHALLENGE Judging pieces. The item can be turned in as one whole item to be cut into or 9 individual pieces.
 - BAKING TURN IN SATURDAY 9:00 AM 9:10 AM
 - BAKING RULES: THE ITEM MUST HAVE BEEN BAKED IN AN OVEN TO QUALIFY. NO ADDITIONAL GARNISHMENTS OTHER THAN RECIPE DECORATION.
 - FOOD Judging will be based on 50 points, decimals are allowed to determine placing. Judging will be based on these categories: Appearance, Doneness, Flavor, Texture, Creativity.

Kids-Cue Rules and Regulations | Open to any child, ages 8 to 18 years.

- SENIOR Kids Cue (13-18 years ONLY: <u>AGE AT TIME OF COMPETITION</u>.) team of 1, turn in ONE whole ribeye. Rules will be discussed at THE PACKET PICK UP WED. 10TH. Competitors ONLY get an event badge to enter the property. MUST BE APART OF A COOK TEAM AS A SPONSOR/PARTICIPANT.
 - TURN IN FRIDAY 6:00 6:10 PM
 - RULES: EACH TEAM WILL DRAW FROM A BAG TO DETERMINE THE SELECTION ORDER OR STEAKS PROVIDED BY THE AG CLUB. EACH TEAM WILL TURN IN 1 WHOLE STEAK COOKED TO MEDIUM TEMPERATURE (warm pink center). NO GARNISHMENTS. NO SIDES. NO BRANDED MARKING DESIGNS OR LOGOS, GRILL MARKS ARE OK. NO VISIABLE BUTTER PRESENT AT TIME OF JUDGING (grounds for disqualification).
 - FOOD Judging will be based on 50 points, decimals are allowed to determine placing. Judging will be based on these categories: Appearance, Doneness, Flavor, Texture, Creativity.
- JUNIOR Kids Cue (ages 8 12 years ONLY: <u>AGE AT TIME OF COMPETITION</u>.) team of 1. Turn in ONE whole ribeye. Rules will be discussed at Head Cook Meeting. MUST BE APART OF A COOK TEAM AS A SPONSOR/PARTICIPANT.
 - JUNIOR KIDS CUE TURN IN FRIDAY 6:50-7:00 PM.
 - THIS AGE GROUP NEEDS THE ASSISTANCE OF ONE ADULT SUPERVISOR, DESIGNATED & REQUIRED.
 - RULES: EACH TEAM WILL DRAW FROM A BAG TO DETERMINE THE SELECTION ORDER OR STEAKS PROVIDED BY THE AG CLUB. EACH TEAM WILL TURN IN 1 WHOLE STEAK COOKED TO MEDIUM TEMPERATURE (warm pink center). NO GARNISHMENTS. NO SIDES. NO BRANDED MARKING DESIGNS OR LOGOS, GRILL MARKS ARE OK. NO VISIABLE BUTTER PRESENT AT TIME OF JUDGING (grounds for disqualification).

- CTE -1^{st} , 2^{nd} , 3^{rd} , in each division will be awarded a plaque. Each participant will have the opportunity to place for silent auction.
- BAKING 1st, 2nd, 3rd will be awarded. First place buckle, second & third place plague.
- KIDS Q COMPETITIONS -1^{st} , 2^{nd} , 3^{rd} with tiered monetary payout based on number of entries for Junior & Senior Divisions. Overall Kids Q grand champion & reserve GC (both divisions combined) will be awarded a buckle.

GENERAL BBQ COOK TEAM INFORMATION

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Rules and Regulations | IBCS BBQ COMPETITORS

- 1. **Cut off for registration is April 1, 2024, or when spots are filled,** whichever comes first. All entries must be paid by April 1, 2023. If you register and do not pay by cut-off date your spot will go to the next person on the wait list.
- 2. PACKET PICK UP WEDNESDAY APRIL 10TH AT PVFD AT 4"00 PM OR UPON ARRIVAL ON FRIDAY.
- 3. Any disorderly conduct is grounds for removal. Keep in mind THIS IS A FAMILY EVENT
- 4. \$250 Fee | Jackpots \$25 | 50% payout | Announce top 10 | Top 3 awards | Grand & Reserve Champions
- 5. Each competition cook team will receive 4 Team Badges. All others will need to pay general admission.
- 6. Tray pick up will be 4:00 pm 6:00 pm Friday Night.
- 7. Additional tray pick up will be 10 am Saturday morning.
- 8. **FRIDAY 6:00 pm Head cook must attend the cook off meeting**. The head cook is responsible for the operation of the team space and all actions within the designated space by members or their guests.
- 9. Head Cook must be onsite and available to the Royal FFA Parents Club Committee if necessary.
- 10. All sites will be 30 x 30. Additional sites available at \$150 for 20X30. **ONE MOTOR VEHICLE** ALLOWED INSIDE THE competition area THIS INCLUDES YOUR RV/CAMPER. ADDITIONAL PARKING for trucks/cars/ATV's WILL BE DESIGATED in parking area.
- 11. Due to the location of the premises & safety of public, <u>BBQ trailers are not permitted leave the grounds during the event</u>; arrival through end of the awards ceremony (approximately after Saturday 7:30 pm).
- 12. Due to the location of the premises & safety of the public, we would prefer vehicles do not leave the premises between the hours of 11:00 pm 6:00 am.
- 13. RV/Campers are allowed for sleeping. No hook ups available. No waste dumping allowed.
- 14. A private port-o-potty can be purchased \$150 per lavatory. DUE APRIL 12TH, PAID IN CASH.
- 15. Team equipment and decorations must fit within the area assigned.



- 16. The Royal FFA Parents Club will only supply teams with space; all other equipment will need to be supplied by cooking teams. Electricity and water will not be supplied. All cooking teams must have a fire extinguisher & fresh running water for hand sanitation.
- 17. Fire holes or open pits are prohibited.
- 18. Propane tanks are permitted for heating / starting purposes but will be used at the discretion and responsibility of the team. Pit fires must be wood or wood substance (charcoal). BBQ pits may have gas or electricity for start only.
- 19. Ice will be available to purchase at \$5 per bag, CASH.
- 20. Trash pick-up will be available. Leave your trash bags VISABLE on the corner of your tent.
- 21. Bars are permitted **inside** tent space, however, **TABC LICENSED BARTENDERS are required. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- 22. All vehicles, trailers, etc. must be removed and your area must be cleaned by SUNDAY at 12:00 PM
- 23. All entries will be cooked onsite. The preparation and completion of all meats and opens must be done within the confines of the cook off site and during the time limits designated by Royal FFA Parents Club.

 Once your team and meats arrive at the event, the meat is not allowed to be removed from the competition grounds.
- 24. No garnish on any protein turns ins.
- 25. IBCA Turn ins will consist of: see IBCA rules, pg. 5
 - 12:00 Noon One (1) Fully jointed chicken half. (To include breast, wing, thigh, and drumstick.)
 - 1:30 P.M. Pork Spareribs eight (8) individual pork Spareribs.
 - 3:00 P.M. Brisket eight (8) Full Slices.
- 26. Jackpots: Turn in containers will be passed out at head judges meeting. Not Sanctioned by IBCA
 - 1 dozen READY TO EAT tamales WRAPPED IN FOIL NO MARKINGS (turn in Friday at 5:00 pm 5:10 pm)
 OPEN TO PUBLIC & COOK TEAMS
 - 1 32 oz full cup of Margarita (turn in Friday at 7:30 7:40 pm) COOK TEAM REQUIRED
 - 1 bag of cow patty (turn in Saturday at 10:00-10:10 am) COOK TEAM REQUIRED
 - 1 32 oz full cup of beans (turn in Saturday at 10:30-10:40 am) COOK TEAM REQUIRED
- 27. Boxes and tickets with turn in foil will be handed out at the cook's meeting.
- 28. ATTENTION: FRIDAY NIGHT QUIET TIME STARTS AT 11 PM. OUT OF RESPECT FOR COOK TEAMS COMPETEING PROFESSIONALLY, KEEP YOUR LATE-NIGHT FUN TO SATURDAY NIGHT. MAKE THE NECESSARY ARRANGEMENTS TO END YOUR FUN AT 11:00 PM AND DO NOT DISTURB OTHER COMPETITION COOK TEAMS FRIDAY NIGHT. A \$350 FINE WILL BE ISSUED BY THE COMMITTEE AND ASKED NOT TO RETURN THE FOLLOWING YEAR. THIS IS YOUR WARNING. NO OTHERS WILL BE GIVEN.
